



# Mobile packet core networks: worldwide forecast 2020– 2028



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## About this report

This report provides forecasts for addressable revenue for vendors in the mobile and converged packet core sector for 2020–2028. It includes details on mobile network operator (MNO) spending by architecture, network function, vendor strategy and region, and also gives a breakdown of spending based on major drivers of change, such as 5G standalone and converged core adoption.

The report is based on several sources, including:

- Analysys Mason’s survey of 86 MNOs about their core investment plans
- interviews with MNOs and vendors worldwide.

- What are the key trends and factors that will affect the mobile core market during 2020–2028?
- Which will be the key areas of new revenue, and how will emerging technologies such as cloud-native cores perform?

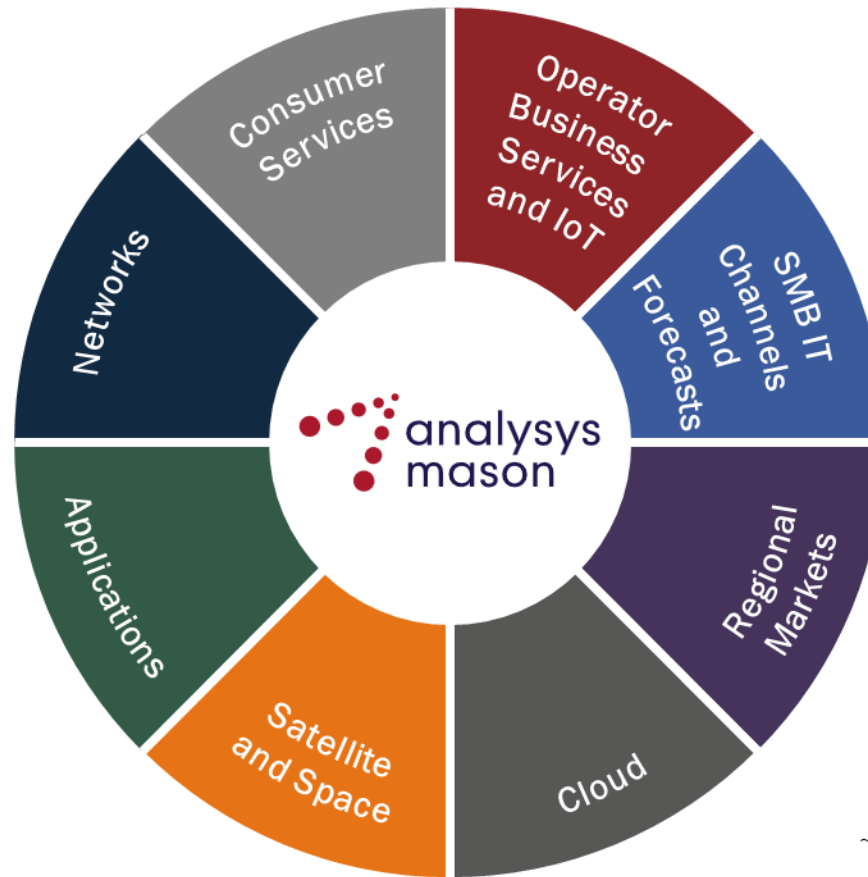
